Music for Freestyle programs will be accepted in the form of CD only.

Application must be postmarked by **Nov 27, 2020**. Make sure you circle all tests required and fill in all applicable fields. **Incomplete applications will not be considered postmarked until they are completed, with full payment.** Applications postmarked after Nov 27, 2020 are accepted at the discretion of the Test Chair and **will require a \$25 late fee.** Priority is given to SC of Brewster Home Club and Associate Members. Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. Test sessions are timed, and cannot be extended. The session may fill up prior to the deadline listed above. Notification will be posted to the Skating Club of Brewster's website and Facebook page. Applications received after a session is full will be returned and you will be notified via email. **Please do not give applications to the test chair or to skaters at the rink. Test fees are non-refundable.** Communication regarding test schedule will be sent via email. Please check your email regularly in the days leading up to the test. **Skaters MUST check in with the test chair 45 minutes prior to their WARM-UP TIME. This is earlier than your scheduled test time and will be clearly indicated on the schedule. Failure to check in on time may result in your entry being cancelled with no refund. If you have any questions, ask the test chair or your coach.**

## TEST APPLICATION AND TEST DAY GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Completed test applications must be postmarked no later than the deadline date posted on the application.
  - a. A coach signature is required. It is highly recommended that you confirm with your coach that you have filled in the application correctly.
  - b. Incomplete applications shall not be accepted and will be returned to the Applicant.
  - c. Applications postmarked after that deadline will be considered late.
    - i. Late Applications received after the application deadline require an additional Late Fee of \$25 per applicant, but are accepted only at the discretion of the Test Chair.
  - d. Test Fees may be paid only by check made payable to Skating Club of Brewster. A \$40 fee shall be charged for all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
  - e. If you are taking more than one test and two different coaches are putting you on, please submit separate applications.
  - f. If you sign up for a MIF and Freestyle test at the same level and do not pass the MIF test, you will not be allowed to take the FS test and the FS test fee will not be refunded.
  - g. If you register for more than one MIF or FS test, you must pass the lower level test first in order to take the higher level test. If you do not pass the lower level test, you may not take the higher level test and the fee will not be refunded.
  - h. Officials' scores are **FINAL**.
  - i. Do not give applications to the Test Chair, Club Officers or to skaters at the rink. Applications are only accepted via mail to the address at the bottom of the form.
  - j. Communication regarding test schedule will be sent via email. Please check your email regularly in the days leading up to the test.
    - i. Additional restrictions and/or instructions may apply for health and safety, and will be communicated to all scheduled skaters
  - k. Music for Freestyle programs will be accepted in the form of CD only.
2. Priority is given to SC of Brewster Home Club and Associate Members. Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received based on postmark.
3. Skaters **MUST** check in with the Test Chair 45 minutes prior to their WARM-UP TIME. This is earlier than your scheduled test time and will be clearly indicated on the schedule. Failure to check in on time may result in your entry being cancelled with no refund. If you have any questions, ask the Test Chair or your Coach.
4. Test sessions may fill up prior to posted deadline - Applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis despite the application deadline based on postmark date on the envelope. Priority will be given to home club members and associate members
  - a. Notification that a test session is full will be posted to the Skating Club of Brewster's website and Facebook page.
  - b. Applications received after a session is full will be returned and you will be notified via email.
5. Checks will be deposited once test schedule is final and posted.
6. Special Scheduling Requests by Applicants and their Coaches must be submitted **IN WRITING** with the Test Application. There are **NO GUARANTEES** that such requests can be accommodated as scheduling involves many variables.
7. Test Fees (including Late Fees) are not refundable so please be sure you are available to test at any time on the scheduled test day. All fees are forfeited if the Applicant withdraws from a test or is unable to take a contingent test.
  - a. Exception for test sessions being held in December 2020 – Should the rink be closed by the county, state or federal government for reasons related to COVID resulting in the test being cancelled, all applications will be returned to applicants.
8. Applicants should be prepared to test up to one hour before their scheduled time. If the Test Session runs early and the Applicant is not present or prepared to test, the Applicant forfeits all fees for that test. The presence of an Applicant's Coach is the responsibility, and at the discretion of the Applicant. An Applicant may retain an alternate coach if his/her Coach is not present.
9. Only Skater and their Coach are allowed on Ice/Ice side.
  - a. Parents/spectators are not allowed ice side for the duration of the test session. Non-compliance will result in a forfeited test for the skater.
10. Test Applications (including Test and Late Fees), Special Scheduling Requests for Applicants and their Coaches, and compliance with the 27-day rule for re-trying tests are the responsibility of the Applicants, their parents and guardians.
11. Coaches need to be USFS coach registered as well as CER compliant, Category A or B. Coaches may be required to show their credentials to the Test Chair at Test Sessions. As of 7/1/18, coaches, partners, judges and certain volunteers need to be SafeSport Compliant. Coaches who are not registered and CER Compliant will not be allowed ice side.
12. Rule 4403 – US Figure Skating and its member clubs (Skate Club of Brewster) conducting tests undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the candidates. As a condition of and in consideration of the acceptance of their applications, all candidates and their parents and /or guardians will be deemed to have agreed to assume all risks of injury to the candidate's person and property resulting from, cause by or connected with the conduct and management of the tests and to release any and all claims which they may have against any officials, US Figure Skating, the Club hosting the tests (Skate Club of Brewster) and against their officers. Applications will be accepted only under the foregoing conditions.
